What is Haley & Aldrich here to do?

Identify foundations within the Newhall Neighborhood CT Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (CTDEEP) Consent Order Boundary that have experienced basement water issues after remediation on their property and/or experienced foundation problems resulting from underlying waste fill.

- Neighborhood was investigated and characterized under CTDEEP oversight from 2000-2010.
- Remediation of about 250 non-public properties occurred in 2011-2013.
- Foundation evaluations of non-public properties occurred from 2001-2024.








• Outreach:

- October Mailing: 305 COB properties contacted
- February Mailing: 209 COB properties contacted
- March: 202 COB properties contacted in person
- Questionnaires sent/received: 670/173
- COB Requests for property visit: 153
- Visits completed/scheduled: 101/13
- Additional visits anticipated: 39
- Potential additional requests: TBD

Property Eligibility and Initial Visit Follow-Up

- The purpose of the property visits completed to date are to screen properties for program eligibility
 - Non-eligible properties: Haley & Aldrich will provide the Town a summary of issues
 - Eligible properties: owners will be contacted to coordinate subsurface investigation and/or sent an engineering report, depending on the issues
- All property visits are followed up by a Notice Letter to the property owner indicating the date of the visit, engineers present, and the basis and status of eligibility for the program
 - Examples of issues for eligible properties:
 - Waste fill that has settled excessively as exhibited by foundation cracks or previous repairs
 - Post-Remediation wet basements
 - Remedial cap repairs required
