ORDER APPROVING FORMAL BID WAIVERS FOR APPROVED SUBRECIPIENTS, VENDORS AND FISCAL SPONSORS FOR APPROVED ARPA RELATED PROJECTS

PRESENTED BY: <u>Legislative Counci</u>l

WHEREAS, the 2021 American Rescue Plan Act ("ARPA") provided \$24,140,338 million dollars to the Town of Hamden from the Coronavirus State and Local Recovery Fund ("SLFRF"), which consists of the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund ("CSFRF") and Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund ("CLFRF") (hereinafter, collectively, called "ARPA funding"); and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Treasury is the federal agency that administers the ARPA funding and has provided the Town with the ARPA funding conditional on the Town complying with its rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, after a Public Input and a Council Process, the allocation and expenditure of ARPA funds and the named Vendors, Subrecipients and Fiscal Sponsors were approved by Order of the Legislative Council for ARPA related Projects; and

WHEREAS, Agreements between the Town of Hamden and Vendors, Subrecipients and Fiscal Sponsors were subsequently approved by Order of the Legislative Council; and

WHEREAS, to ensure compliance with the Code of Federal Regulations Part 200, Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards, it is requested that formal bid waivers be approved for the named Vendors, Subrecipients and Fiscal Sponsors as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that in compliance with Code of Federal Regulations Part 200, Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards, retroactively to the date the Council named the Vendors, Subrecipients and Fiscal Sponsors by Order, the Legislative Council approves formal bid waivers as follows:

- 1. We Are the Village, Inc., \$50,000 (Vendor)
- 2. Lifting Others Virtuously Everyday, \$5,000 (Vendor)
- 3. Fixing Fathers One Day at a Time, \$20,000 (Vendor)
- 4. Save the Sound, \$40,000 (Vendor)
- 5. Next Level Empowerment Program, Inc., \$142,500 (Vendor)
- 6. United Way of Greater New Haven on behalf of Hamden Partnership for Young Children, \$165,000 (Fiscal Sponsorship)
- 7. United Way of Greater New Haven on behalf of Community Action Network, \$1,000,000 (Subrecipient)
