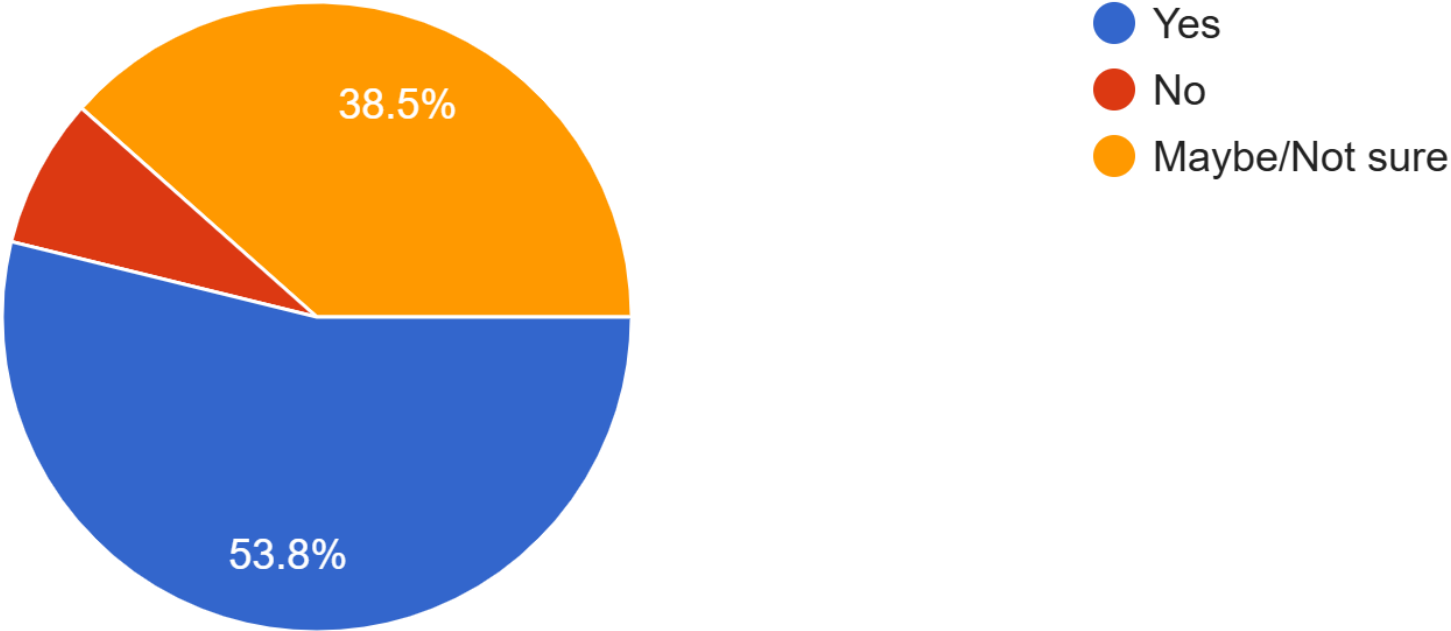

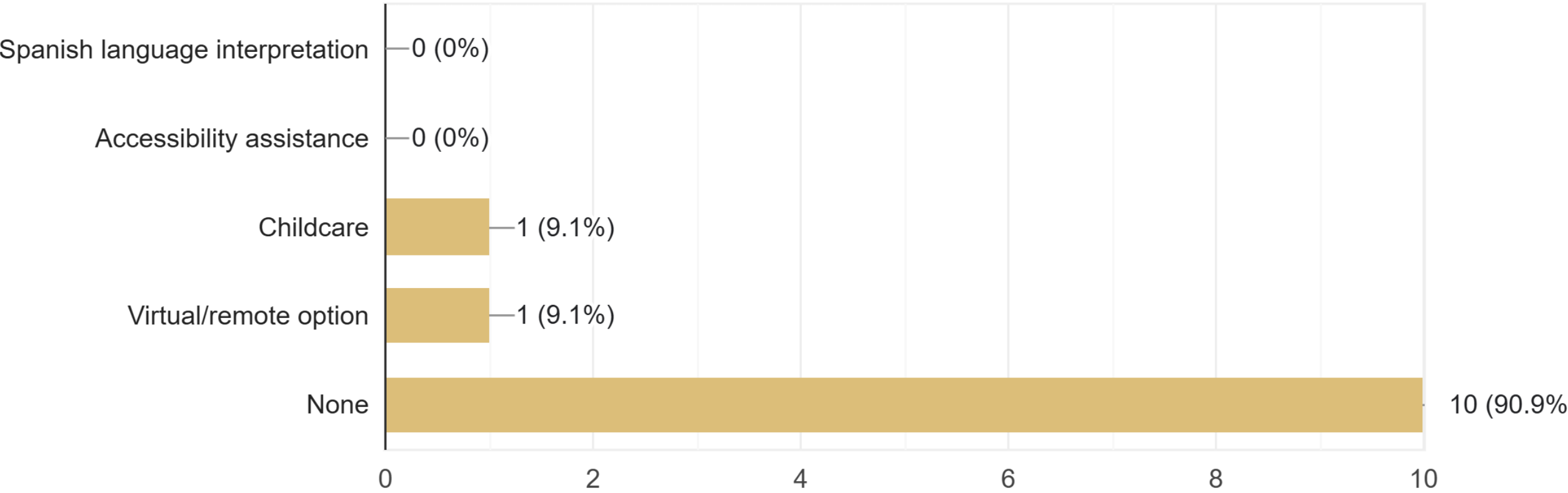
Do you plan on attending the February 19th meeting?*

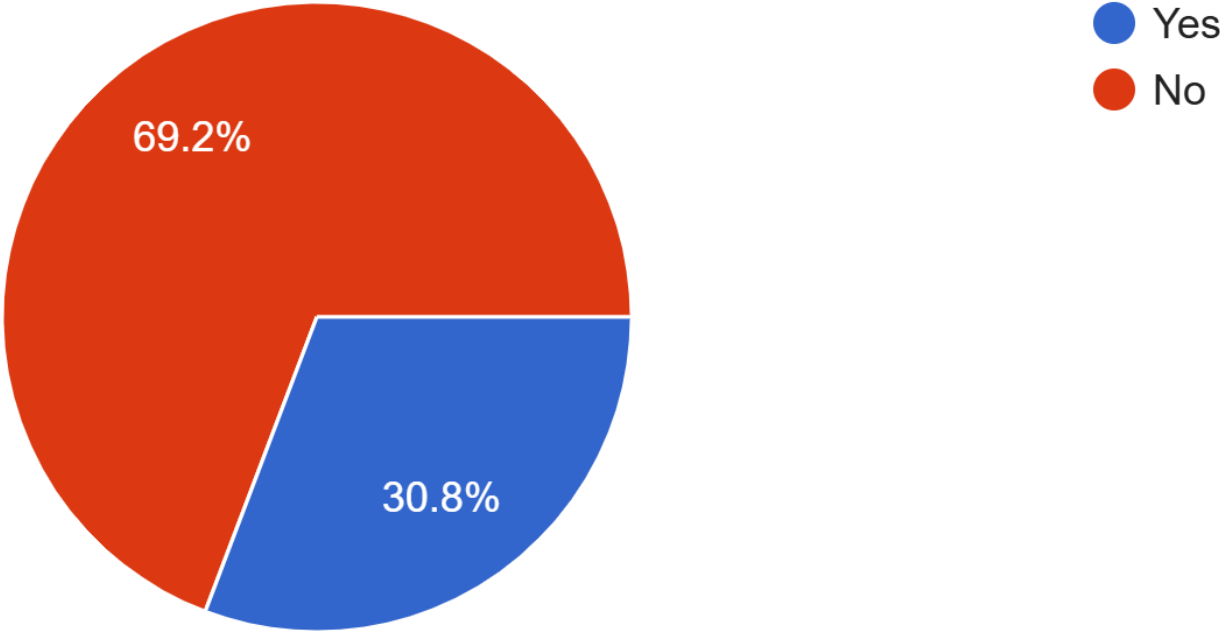
Do you need any accommodations to attend? (Select all that apply)

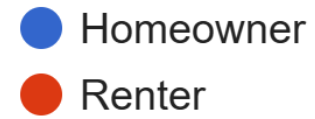
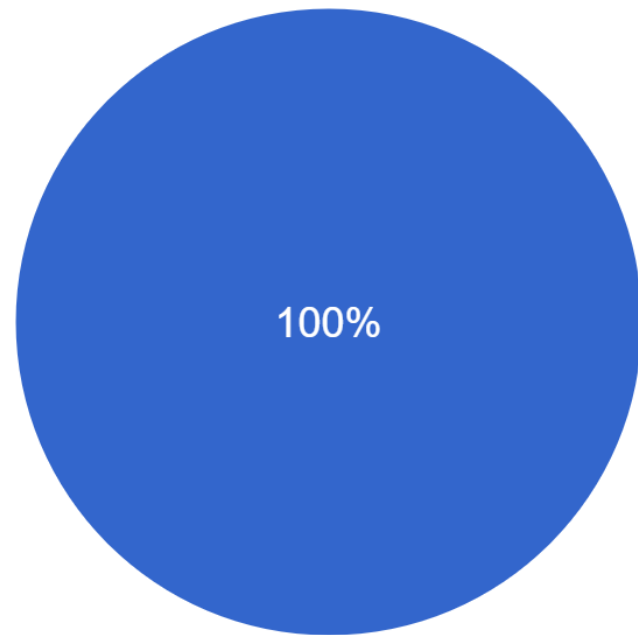
Do you live in the Newhall neighborhood?

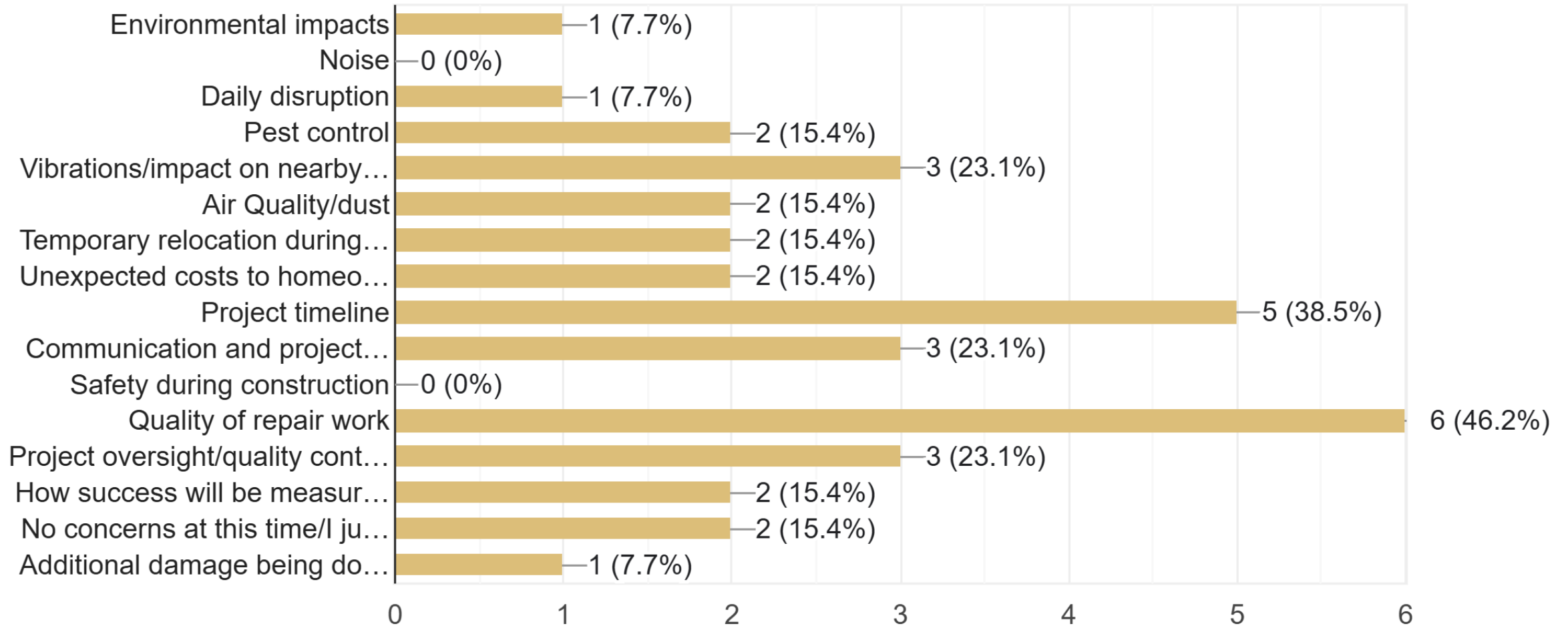
Are you a homeowner or renter?*

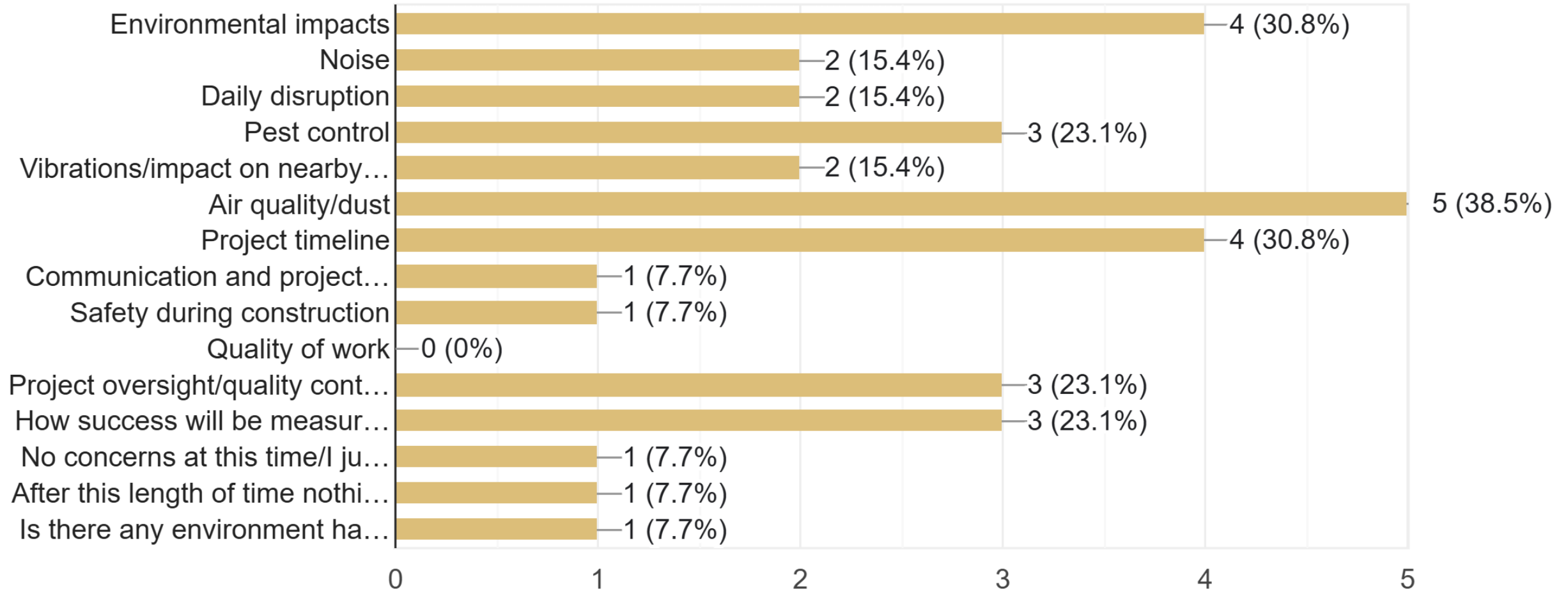

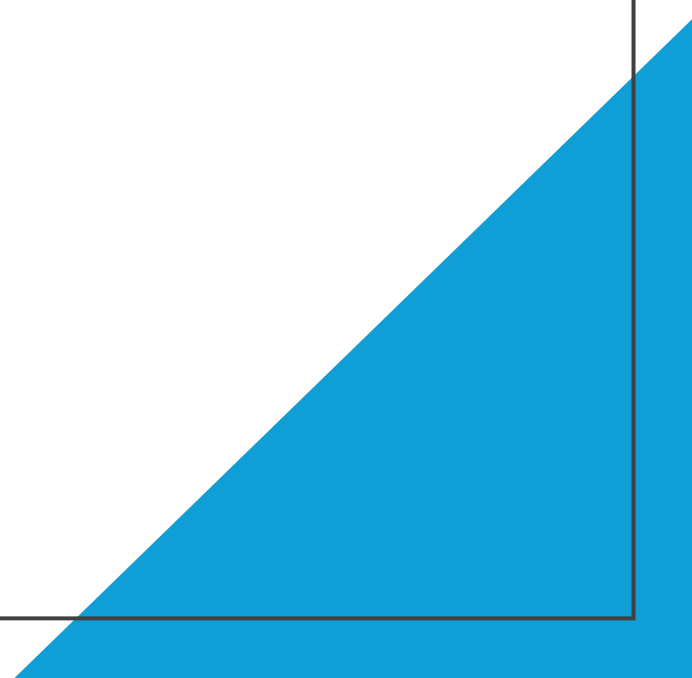


How confident are you that there will be clear opportunities to raise concerns and receive responses?
